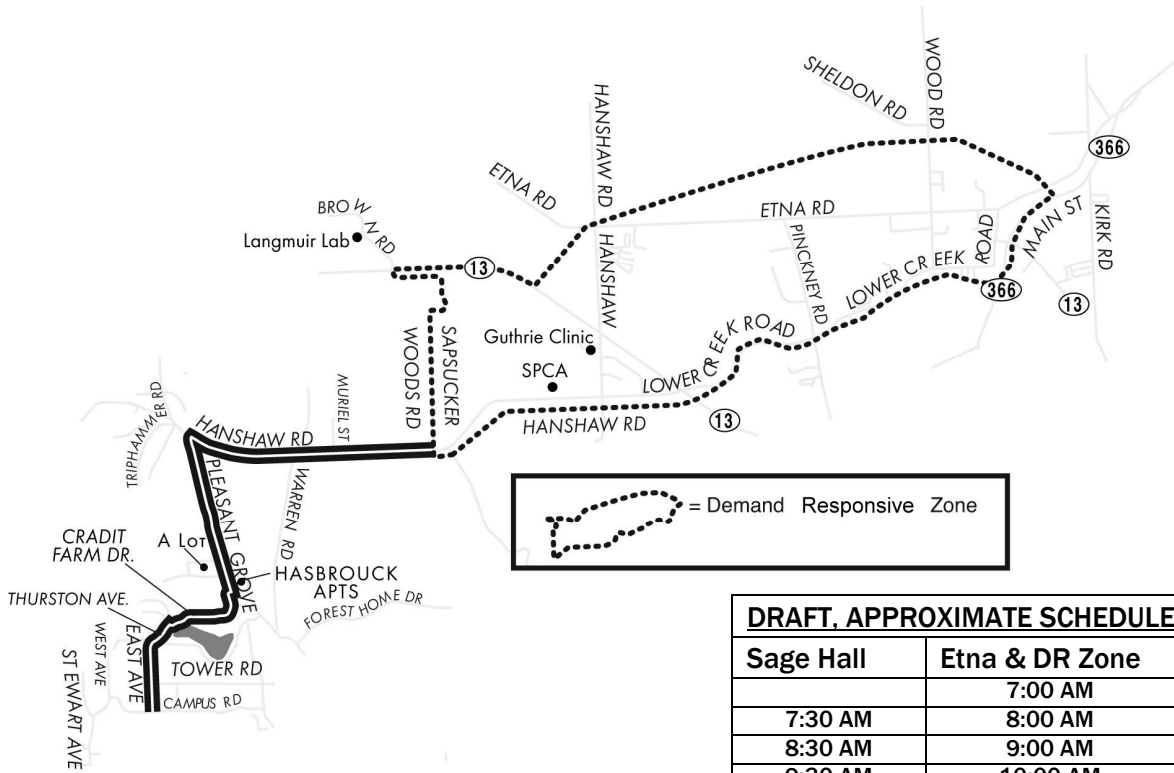


Route 41

- **Proposed Recommendations:**

- Operate a fixed-route bus route from Cornell's campus → Pleasant Grove Road → Hanshaw Road. This route will operate four morning trips, one mid-day trip, and four evening trips.
- Create a Demand-Responsive zone that covers Sapsucker Woods neighborhood, Lower Creek Road neighborhood, and Etna.
 - **What is Demand-Responsive? Why Demand-Responsive instead of a fixed-route bus?** Demand-responsive transit responds to unique ridership patterns. It can cover larger areas of lower density development than a fixed bus route, because it constantly changes its routing in response to changes in demand.
 - **How can I depend on Demand-Responsive transit?**
 - Schedule a pick-up: If you'd like a ride on the Rt. 41, give the TCAT Bus Dispatcher a call. They will schedule a pick-up time and location with you. Be ready at your pick-up location at your designated time, and get on our mini-bus. The mini-bus may drive around to pick up other passengers, and then it will get back "on route" to your scheduled destination. If you are a regular rider, you can set up a subscription with the TCAT Bus Dispatcher, so you won't have to call for your ride every day.
 - Schedule a drop-off: To get home, board a Rt. 41 on Cornell's campus, along Hanshaw Road, etc. Tell the driver where you would like to disembark. It's that simple!
 - Your pick-up and drop-off times must be within the time windows of the regularly scheduled Rt. 41 trips (see above).
- Continue to operate five days per week, Monday through Friday, like the existing Rt. 41. Weekend service is maintained on the Rt. 44.

- **Changes as a Result of Public Input:**

- In response to public input, one mid-day trip was added to the schedule.
- Public input highlighted the need to continue weekend service from this area to the Shops at Ithaca Mall. To serve this need, the Rt. 44 in its existing format was added back to the recommendations.
